Visitor Parking Permit

HOW TO OBTAIN A PERMIT

- Permanent District of Columbia residents may obtain visitor parking permits for guests free of charge at a police station or substation in the ward they reside.
- Special consideration will be given to residents who are incapacitated or have a disability.
- Permits are issued free of charge to residents with visitors.
- Permits are only issued to eligible DC residents and are for use only by their actual visitors.
 - ✓ A resident is "eligible" when s/he resides on a street that has been designated as a residential parking permit area.
 - ✓ A visitor is defined as any person who visits a DC residence.

Visitor Parking Permit

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR RESIDENTS

Applicants must provide one of the following as proof of District of Columbia residency:

A valid DC driver's license/identification card

A valid DC vehicle registration card

A current utility bill, lease, deed, settlement agreement or voter registration card

Visitor Parking Permit

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS FOR VISITORS

Application forms for visitor parking permits must show the following :

Name and address of the visitor using the permit

Name and address of resident

License plate number and issuing state of visitor's vehicle

Visitor Parking Permit

PERMIT VALIDATION

To be valid, visitor permits must display the following :

License plate number of the visitor's vehicle

Expiration date (no more than 15 days from the date of issuance)

Ward number of the DC resident

New Car Temporary Parking Permit

OBTAINING A PERMIT

- Permits are only issued to District residents.
- A resident must reside on a RPP zoned street.
- May be issued when a resident purchases a new or used vehicle and receives temporary tags from the dealership to use while paperwork is being processed at DMV
- Permits may be obtained at the police station, substation or DMV
- Permit is free of charge and valid for up to 45 days.
 - Permit is not renewable since hard tags must be obtained within the 45 day period
- The permit may only be used by a District resident.

PERMIT REQUIREMENTS

DC resident or dealership must present the following documents at a DMV Service Center :

Valid temporary tag registration

Proof of DC insurance for the vehicle

A copy of DC driver's license

DOCUMENTS & REQUIREMENTS FOR OBTAINING A PERMIT

- Valid vehicle registration.
- Proof of valid vehicle insurance.
- Statement from residential property owner certifying that construction, plumbing, painting, etc. is being performed on the property
- Copy of property WHAT ??? and estimated length of project.
- Copy of residential property owner's DC driver's license or identification card.

Contractual Employee Temporary Parking Permit

- Contractors may qualify for a contractual temporary parking permit when renovating or repairing a District home.
- The contractor's vehicle must display commercial tags and the company's name.
- The parking permit is issued at no charge and valid for 15 days at a time.

Residential Parking Permit (RPP)

- Allows a DC registered vehicle or a vehicle with reciprocity to park without restriction in the permit area.
- To be eligible for RPP enforcement, the street in question must be zoned and display two hour residential restriction signage.
- Commercial vehicles, buses, vehicles longer than 22 ft and sight seeing vehicles are not eligible for RPPs.
- Permits are issued by DMV as part of the vehicle registration service.
- Permits may be requested online

Residential Parking Permit (RPP)

Applicants must pay applicable permit fees and present the following documents at a DMV Service Center:

Valid DC vehicle registration card

Valid DC driver's license or valid DC non-driver's ID card

Apportioned Vehicles

Any vehicle that travels in the District and at least one other jurisdiction that is used for transporting property or persons for profit, is defined as an apportioned vehicle

A power unit with a gross vehicle weight in excess of 26,000 pounds from the manufacturer

A power unit with three or more axles, regardless of weight

AP
VEHICLE
CRITERIA

A carrier with power units that travel from its base jurisdiction into another jurisdiction

A power unit used in combination with another unit which together exceeds 26,000 pounds

Apportioned Vehicles

- Vehicles that meet the apportioned vehicle criteria and travel into DC while licensed in MD, VA or any other jurisdiction must display a valid apportioned tag.
- Vehicle owners must contact the DMV in their jurisdiction about IRP registration or secure a Trip Permit before entering the City.
- Owners/operators of vehicles that are not in compliance will be subject to a \$500 fine.
- To bring an oversized and/or overweight vehicle into the District, the Department of Transportation (DDOT) must be contacted in order to secure a permit.
- If a vehicle is detained, the MPD Motor Carrier Safety Unity will apply the federal bridge formula when determining if an overweight vehicle exceeds DC weight regulations.

FAQ - PERMITS

Q : How to get Residential Permit Parking (RPP) signs posted on a street or block ?

A : Make a request by doing the following:

1. Call the Department of Transportation (DDOT), at 202-671-2381 or
2. Contact your Advisory Neighborhood Commissioner (ANC).
3. A survey will be conducted by DDOT and the results mail to the residents.
4. If approved for RPP, signs will be posted and your ANC will be notified...
5. A different RPP sticker for each vehicles registered within the household will be required.
6. Notices are mailed to all residents in the block before the program becomes effective.

FAQ - PERMITS

Q : Why are tickets issued when vehicles move before the two hours in a RPP zone/street/block?

A : Although vehicles may park without penalty for up to two hours in a RPP zone, tickets may be issued either within or after the two hours when:

1. Another sign prohibits parking. E.g. (Street Cleaning, AM or PM Rush Hour).
2. The vehicle Displays expired tags or no tags.
3. The vehicle is missing a front or Rear tag (DC/MD/VA only)
4. The vehicle Displays an expired inspection or is missing an inspection sticker. (DC/VA only)
5. The vehicle is commercial, a bus, sightseeing or longer than 22 feet.
6. The vehicle moved from a RPP block to another RPP block within the same zone/ward.
7. Each additional two hours a vehicle remains in the same RPP zone represents a separate violation.
8. To avoid citations, obtain a valid RPP permit, a visitor or a temporary permit or reciprocity sticker with RPP for the residential zone/street/block. Or move to another RPP zone or to a non-restricted block.

FAQ - PERMITS

Q : How can a resident obtain a Residential Permit Parking (RPP) permit for a guest or constructors when they visit?

A : The DC resident or home owner must do the following:

1. Go to the nearest Department of Motor Vehicles office or the nearest police station or substation in his or her ward.
2. Request a visitor parking permit for visitors or a Temporary Parking Permit for constructors.
3. The visitor permit is good for 15 days from the date of issuance and temporary permit for constructors will accommodate the estimated length of their work or service.
4. The visitor and temporary permit are free.
5. Special consideration is given to disable residents.

Q : What information will the resident need for the permits?

A : The application requires the following information :

- 1) The resident street name and address.
- 2) Name and address of the visitor/constructor using the permit.
- 3) The visitor's vehicle license plate number and state of registration.

FAQ – PERMITS

Q : Can commercial vehicles obtain a visitor permit?

A : Nope, Commercial vehicles, buses, sightseeing and vehicles longer than twenty-two (22 ft) are not eligible for residential permit parking.

Q : What can persons with out-of-state tags do to obtain a residential permit?

A1: Ask the DC resident or family member you are visiting to request from the nearest DMV office or Police station a visitor or temporary parking permit for your vehicle.

A2: Within 30 days change the drivers license and vehicle registration to District of Columbia.

A3: Return to their state or jurisdiction, unless...

A4: The person meets the qualifications for reciprocity and obtain a reciprocity sticker with a residential permit for the ward/zone. The qualifications for reciprocity are:

- a) The President and Vice President of the United States and staff members.
- b) Members of congress & House Representatives and their staff.
- c) Active members of the United States armed forces and their wife/children.
- d) Diplomats representing a foreign country or mission in the District.
- e) Full time students attending an accredited college or university in the District (Georgetown and American university excepted)
- f) A DC temporary resident (a one time 6 month period only)

FAQ - TICKET PAYMENT

Q : What are my options for paying a ticket?

1. If you agree with the violation you must pay the infraction within 30 calendar day from the date on the ticket. If you do not pay within 30 calendar days, a penalty equal to your fine will be added.
2. You have four payment options: online, by mail, in person, or by phone at (866) 893-5023.
3. You may be eligible to [pay your ticket\(s\) in installments](#).
4. Online payment http://dmv.washingtondc.gov/external/transfer_tickets.shtm
 - a. Have your ticket number information
 - b. A credit card available.
 - c. Visa, MasterCard, and Discover are accepted.
 - d. American Express is not accepted .

FAQ - TICKET PAYMENT

Q : What are my options for paying a ticket?

5. Mail Payment

- a. Do not send cash
- b. Make your check or money order payable to the **DC Treasurer**.
- c. Write the ticket number on the check or money order or .
- d. Write the vehicle's state and tag number on your check or money order.
- e. Send your parking, photo enforcement or moving violation with check to: DMV Adjudication Services, PO Box 2014, Washington, DC 20013.

6. In Person

- a. Payments are accepted at [Adjudication Services](#).
- b. Take your ticket to the cashier window.
- c. Don't have the ticket, present your ID to obtain a printout
- d. Pay with cash, check, money order, or credit card.
- e. Visa, MasterCard, and Discover accepted.
- f. If paying with other than cash, you must present a valid driver's license, DMV-issued non-drivers ID, passport, or military ID.
- g. Checks are not accepted for the release of booted or towed vehicles.

FAQ - TICKET PAYMENT

Q : What are my options if I want to contest a ticket?

1. You may contest a parking ticket by mail or by appearing at a walk-in hearing within 60 days of the date issued.
2. If don't want to contest the ticket. Pay it within 30 days.
3. If you don't contest within 30 calendar days a penalty equal to the fine will be added, and...you may lose your opportunity to have a hearing.
4. If the ticket is more than 60 days old, submit a [Motion to Vacate Judgment](#)* to determine whether you may still contest the ticket.
5. Your Motion to Vacate Judgment must be received within 120 calendar days from the date the ticket was issued.
6. If you paid the ticket you can no longer adjudicate the ticket.
7. Therefore, if you are within the 120 days of the ticket being issued and you want to dispute the penalty, you should not pay any portion of the ticket.
8. Only request a hearing if you:
 - a. Admit with explanation = Submit a written explanation.
 - b. Denying the alleged violation = Mail your written defense or present your defense in a walk-in, unscheduled hearing.

FAQ - TICKET PAYMENT

Q : What are acceptable reasons for contesting a ticket?

A1. You may only claim one of the following defenses.

- a. You were not the owner or lessee of the vehicle on the date that the ticket was issued.
- b. The vehicle or vehicle tags were stolen on or before the date the ticket was issued.
- c. The relevant meter was broken through no fault of your own
- d. The relevant sign was missing or obscured
- e. The stipulated facts on the ticket are inconsistent or do not support the violation.
- f. The vehicle experienced sudden mechanical failure
- g. The driver or passenger of the vehicle required immediate medical attention (proof of medical attention required)

FAQ - TICKET PAYMENT

Q : Can I submit an adjudication request [online](#) for a ticket?

9. Yes, an adjudication request can be submitted [online](#).
 - a. Submit request within 60 calendar days of the ticket issue date or the mail date if the ticket is for a photo enforced violation..
 - b. If you do not contest or pay within 30 calendar days, a penalty equal to the fine will be added.
 - c. Complete the online [adjudication form](#), summarizing your defense.
 - d. Submit the form and upload any evidence, such as photographs or receipts, which you think might help your case.
 - e. The file format is noted at the end of the online document.
 - f. An e-mail acknowledgment will be sent to the e-mail address you provide.
 - g. The hearing examiner's decision letter will be mailed to the registered owner within six months unless a DC DMV [Email Ticket Alert Service](#) (TAS) account is established which would allow you to receive an e-mail advising that a decision has been made.
 - h. If you open a [TAS](#) account, you will be able to review the decision the same day it is made. You will also be able to monitor all tickets and hearings associated with the registered tag(s) in the account.

FAQ - PUBLIC SPACE

Q : Where does public space begin and end ?

A : Public space starts from the curb to the front door of a business or private home.

Q : How long can a vehicle remain on a public street before it is towed?

A : **A :** If lawfully parked “No Time Limit”, unless these scenarios exist:

1. The vehicle is parked in an illegal parking space.
2. The vehicle is an imminent hazard to public safety, serves as a shelter for pets, rats and other animals or.
3. After an investigation the vehicle is confirmed to be abandoned.
4. The vehicle exceeded 30 calendar days within the District, with out state tags and did not obtain a reciprocity sticker or exemption from ROSA.
5. Displaying expired or missing tags. Or a missing front or Rear tag.
6. Displaying an expired or missing inspection sticker.

FAQ - METER ZONES

Q : Why did I receive a ticket before I had a chance to put money in the meter?

A : There are other scenarios that can cause a violation :

1. The driver is required to pay immediately after occupying a meter.
2. Exceeding the time limit posted or allowed for the meter zone.
3. Another sign prohibited parking when the infraction was issued. E.g. (Street Cleaning, AM or PM Rush Hour).
4. Displaying expired or missing tags. Or a missing front or Rear tag
5. Displaying an expired or missing inspection sticker.
6. The vehicle exceeds the length of the parking space.
7. The vehicle is not parked within the parking meter zone or taking two meter spaces.

FAQ - METER ZONES

A : A : There are other scenarios that can cause a violation :

1. Exceeding the time limit posted or allowed for the meter zone.
2. Another sign prohibited parking when the infraction was issued.


