

Attention Army Reservists!



Continue your service in the Nation's Capital — with the Metropolitan Police Department



Minimum Requirements at time of application:

- ★ Be at least 21 years of age
- ★ Be a citizen of the United States
- ★ Have completed at least 60 hours of college credits or 3 years of active duty Armed Forces or Organized Reserves/National Guard service or 5 years of prior police experience
- ★ Possess an honorable military discharge if separated
- ★ Possess a valid driver's license

The starting salary is: **\$48,715**. After a probationary 18 months of service, the salary increases to **\$53,300**.

Police Officer candidates must successfully pass a written examination, and a thorough background investigation that includes a medical examination, vision testing, drug screening and a psychological evaluation.

MP Lateral Transfer Program

Candidates with prior Military Police service may qualify for the Lateral Transfer Officer Program. Salary is commensurate with experience from **\$51,151** to **\$71,971**.

No previous law enforcement experience is required to be considered for employment. Applicants must meet the minimum requirements at the time of application.
